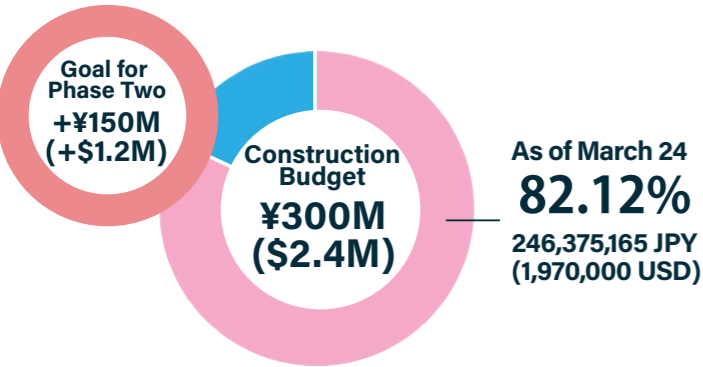

By dividing the main construction contract into two phases, we aim to spread out the payments and make every possible effort to raise the remaining funds for Phase Two during Phase One. As we approach Phase One, we have already entered into a purchase contract for the primary structural timber at 39,000,000 JPY (312,000 USD) at the end of 2025.

However, due to global circumstances and rising material costs, the total is now expected to be 450,000,000 JPY (3,600,000 USD).

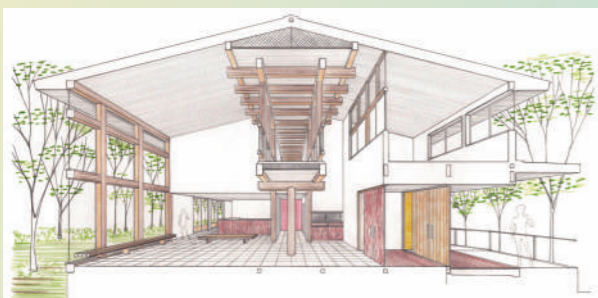

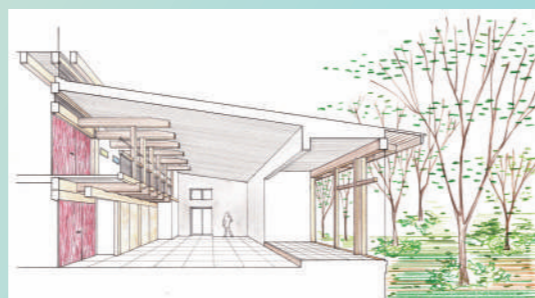

# 2024

In December, we contracted for and purchased the timber, and in January, it was harvested. The timber will now be dried in preparation for the construction.
